

Merle Holden

Professor Merle Holden is Emeritus Professor in the School of Economics and Finance at the University of KwaZulu-Natal, Durban. After graduating from the University of Natal with an Honours degree, she completed her graduate study in the US and holds a Ph.D. in Economics from Duke University. She was Associate Professor of Economics at George Mason University in Virginia, US, before returning to South Africa in 1982 to the University of Natal.

Her areas of specialization are in international trade theory and policy, open economy macroeconomics and competition policy. Her research has been published in the Review of Economics and Statistics, World Economy, The South African Journal of Economics, Journal of Economic Development and Development Southern Africa.

She served as Head of the School of Economics and Management and Dean of the Faculty at the University of Natal. She is a past president of the Economic Society of South Africa and has consulted for the World Bank and UNCTAD. She has been a part time member of the Competition Tribunal of South Africa since 1999.
