### **Employment history**

Mbuyiseli Madlanga worked as a law lecture (part and full time) at the University of Transkei. Practiced as an Advocate, Was a judge of High Court, Acted as a Judge of Appeal in the Supreme Court of Appeal in Bloemfontein, Acted as a Judge President of the Transkei division of the High Court, Appointed to the then newly established Competition Appeal Court (but retaining permanent position on the High Court bench), Acted as a Judge of the Constitutional Court of South Africa.

Mbuyiseli resigned from the judiciary and started practice as senior counsel from 01 June 2001, keeping chambers in Mthatha as well as Johannesburg.

Appointed by the President as a part-time member of the Competition Tribunal from 2003 to 2009, and then re-appointed as a Deputy chairperson of same from 2009 to date. Some of his other appointments include being appointed by the Minister of Finance as Chairperson of the Exchange Control and Income Tax Amnesty from June 2003 to date and appearing before the International Court of Justice at The Hague, Netherlands on behalf of the Republic of South Africa in the matter of the "Separation Wall constructed by the Israel on Occupied Palestinian Territory". He has also been appointed by the President as a member of the Judicial Service Commission pursuant to a nomination by the General Council of the Bar (AFT Component).
