
ORDER

The Competition Tribunal orders as follows:

1. The Second Respondent should grant access in terms of section 45(1) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998 (as amended), to all information submitted to the Second Respondent by the First Respondent. Such

information shall be provided only to the applicant's legal representatives and expert economists subject to appropriate confidentiality undertakings.

2. The Applicants are granted leave to supplement their pleadings if they intend proceeding with an application requesting access to be widened to persons other than the applicants legal representatives and economic experts.
