

Competition Tribunal's Integrated Report receives Merit Award

The Competition Tribunal's Integrated Annual Report for the 2016/2017 Financial Year has received the prestigious Merit Award for the public sector category in this year's Integrated Reporting Awards, co-hosted by Chartered Secretaries Southern Africa (CSSA) and the Johannesburg Stock Exchange.

The Integrated Reporting Awards took place at the Montecasino ballroom on Wednesday, 16 November, 2016 with the guest list including entrants from the top 40 listed companies, as well as unlisted companies and small and medium cap companies, non-government organisations and the public sector.

The Integrated Reporting Awards, started in 1956, is intended to recognise good governance and compliance with integrated reporting requirements put in place under the leadership of Mervyn King.

According to CSSA CEO Stephan Sadie, the judges in this competition evaluated whether the report stood out in the industry and whether the entrant's disclosure was in line with the latest global trends and local best practice.
